**MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 2008 – 25
Committee on Education**

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING PERTINENT PROVISIONS OF MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 02 SERIES OF 2002 PARTICULARLY SECTIONS 6- ON THE GENERAL GUIDELINES AND SECTION II- ON THE TRANSITORY PROVISIONS.

Be it ordained by the Sangguniang Bayan of Hungduan, Ifugao in session assembled that:

SECTION 1. TITLE. This ordinance shall be known and cited as the HAPIDS (Hungduan Assistance to Poor, Interested and Deserving Students) Program Ordinance of 2002.

SECTION 2. DECLARATION OF POLICY. It shall be the policy of the Local Government of Hungduan to provide opportunities, especially to poor but deserving students who are interested to obtain their education, thereby enhancing the development of their talents.

SECTION 3. APPLICABILITY. The provisions shall apply to any students endorsed by the school head and meet the requirements set by the Local Government Unit.

SECTION 4. EXCEPTION. Any students endorsed by the office of the MSWDO, who are identified as indigent family,.

SECTION 5. EDUCATIONAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM. The Local Government Unit of Hungduan will establish an educational assistance program to cater the needs of poor but deserving students who are interested to obtain their high school and college education.

SECTION 6. GENERAL GUIDELINES.

1. Applicant must belong to the top 20% of the graduating class certified by the school head.
2. The educational assistance program is distributed in every Barangay, one college and two high school per school year.
3. The applicant must have gross annual income of not more than forty five thousand pesos (P45,000.00)
4. The applicant must choose to enroll in any recognized private and government school.
5. The applicant must pass the screening examination conducted by the Local Government Unit.

6. The grantee must not be a recipient of any other scholarship or grants.
7. The awardees must maintain a grade not lower than 80% as a requirement for the assistance to be continued.
8. The awardees must comply with the terms and condition of the educational assistance agreement to be entered into between himself/herself, parents or guardian and the Local Government Unit.
9. Applicant must be a permanent resident of Hungduan.
10. The applicant must have graduated from any recognized elementary school to qualify to the secondary program within the Municipality of Hungduan.
11. For college assistance, he/she maybe a graduate from any recognized secondary institution but are residents of this municipality.
12. The final selection shall be on their final rating certified by the office of the Human Resources Management Officer (HRMO).
13. Except any students endorsed by the Municipal Social Welfare and Development Office, who are identified as indigent family.

SECTION 7. EDUCATIONAL ASSISTANCE BENEFITS. Tuition fee and other miscellaneous fees.

SECTION 8. PROGRAM IMPLEMENTATION. The Local Government Unit through the Human Resource Management Officer (HRMO) shall administer the program. The HRMO shall is hereby tasked to formulate the necessary implementing rules and regulations and relevant policies to be approved by the Sangguniang Bayan.

SECTION 9. ASSISTING IMPLEMENTORS. To ensure the close supervision, the committees on Education are entitled to keep and make a report to the Sangguniang Bayan to ensure the proper implementation of the Local Government Unit Assistance program.

SECTION 10. FUNDING SOURCE. The Educational Assistance fund shall be included yearly in the annual budget of the Local Government under the Program Fund.

SECTION 11. TRANSITORY PROVISIONS.

- A. There shall be nine (9) college students and 18 high school students selected for the initial year of implementation of the program.
- B. There shall be 18 college students and 36 high school students for the second year of implementation.
- C. There shall be 27 college students and 54 high school students for the third year of implementation.
- D. There shall be 36 college students and 72 high school students for the fourth year of implementation.

- E. The amount of Two Thousand Pesos (P2, 000.00) per college students per semester and Five Hundred Pesos (P500.00) per high school students per year is hereby appropriated for its implementation.

SECTION 12. Any increase in budgetary support shall be recommended by the HRMO, MSWDO and the Committee on Education, when the need arises.

SECTION 13. EFFECTIVITY. This municipal ordinance shall take effect upon the approval by the Sangguniang Panlalawigan, Lagawe, Ifugao or 30 days after submission without any action.
