**Municipal Ordinance No. 43**

**AN ORDINANCE PRESCRIBING THE STANDARD RATES OF FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO INDIVIDUALS IN CRISIS SITUATION (AICS) AND EMERGENCY SHELTER ASSISTANCE (ESA); AND SETTING GUIDELINES FOR GIVING THE SAME.**

Be it enacted by the body in session that:

**Section 1. - TITLE** -This ordinance shall be known and cited as **“Financial Assistance to Individuals in Crisis Situation”**

**Section 2. DEFINITION OF TERMS**

**a. The Assistance to Individuals in Crisis Situation (AICS)**- financial assistance to individuals or families whose normal functioning has been hampered due to difficult situations brought about by dysfunctional situations that may be caused by poor health conditions, natural and man-made calamities, and other crisis situations.

**b. Earthquake**- a sudden and violent shaking of the ground, sometimes causing great destruction as a result of movements within the earth’s crust or volcanic action.

**c. Emergency Shelter assistance (ESA)** - Financial assistance to augment resources of affected families who opted not to be transferred to a resettlement site to enable them to purchase materials for their damaged houses. It is also known as “Self-build” shelter assistance.

**d. Erosion**- the process by which the surface of the earth gets worn down or removes soil and rock from one location on the earth’s crust, then transport it to another location where it is deposited.

**e. Fire**- a state, process, or instance of combustion in which fuel or other material is ignited and combined with oxygen, giving off light, heat and flame.

**f. Land slide**- a geological phenomenon that includes a wide range of ground movements, such as rock falls, deep failure of slopes and shallow debris flows. Landslides can occur in offshore, coastal and onshore environments.

**g. Typhoon**- a tropical cyclone with the

maximum wind of 34 knots or higher. Typhoons feature heavy rains and winds that maintain speed equal to or greater than 74 miles (119 km) per hour.

**Section 2. – RATES.** The following are the rates of financial assistance:

**Section 3. QUALIFICATIONS.** This AICS program shall be one time in a year assistance to **constituents of legal age**, registered voters and residents of Hungduan; and either parents/guardians is a registered voters/resident of Hungduan, if the client is under age.

**Section 4. REPEALING CLAUSE.** Any other ordinances, resolutions and policies of the Municipal Government contrary or inconsistent with this ordinance are hereby deemed repealed.

**Section 5. SEPARABILITY** Clause. Should any part of this ordinance be declared unconstitutional or invalid by proper authority, the other parts or provisions hereof which are not affected shall continue to be in full force and effect.

**Section 6. EFFECTIVITY.** This ordinance shall take effect upon approval.
